Cllr Guest asked Cllr C Brickley for a brief update following the CDC Climate Emergency Conference that she recently attended. Cllr Brickley said that this matter was of great importance and that it is the intention of the CDC to work closely with the parishes and towns to achieve their aim of becoming a net-zero Council by 2045. The 22 page report from CDC detailing all the responses from those that had attended was very interesting and far-reaching, however certain items were within the scope of our Council, such as encouraging people to recycle, re-use and repair, to shop local, perhaps re-introducing a farmers market, the use of low energy light bulbs,

consult with the Village Hall regarding their energy suppliers. The aim is to reduce waste and consider renewable energy. CDC will guide us. Cllr C Brickley to prepare an article for possible publication on the website, next newsletter and CHEQS magazine.

 The 420 trees ordered earlier in the year have arrived and Cllr Giles and a working group of volunteers will be planting these saplings in locations around the village. Contact with landowners in the area and Jubilee Field Committee has been ongoing to establish places where the saplings can be planted. One suggestion is to create an area for a garden of remembrance, and this will be put to Jubilee Field Committee.
